- High input impedance : $10^{12}\Omega$

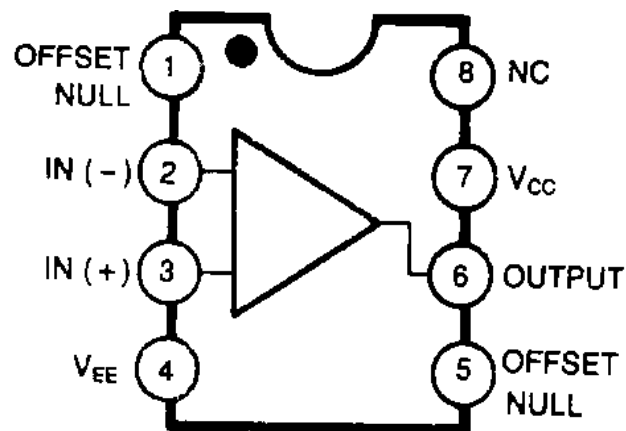
Description

The KF351 is JFET input operational amplifier with an internally compensated input offset voltage. The JFET input device provides wide bandwidth, low input bias currents and offset currents.

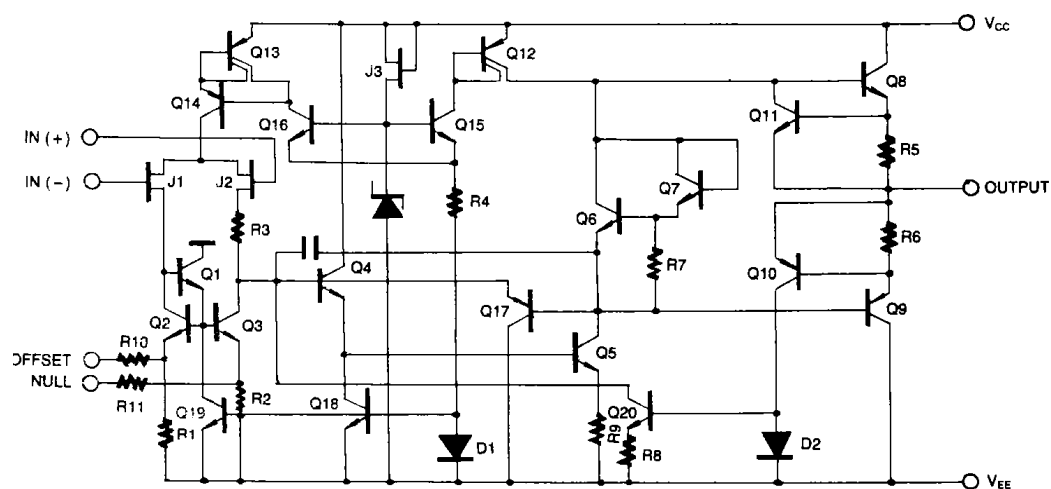

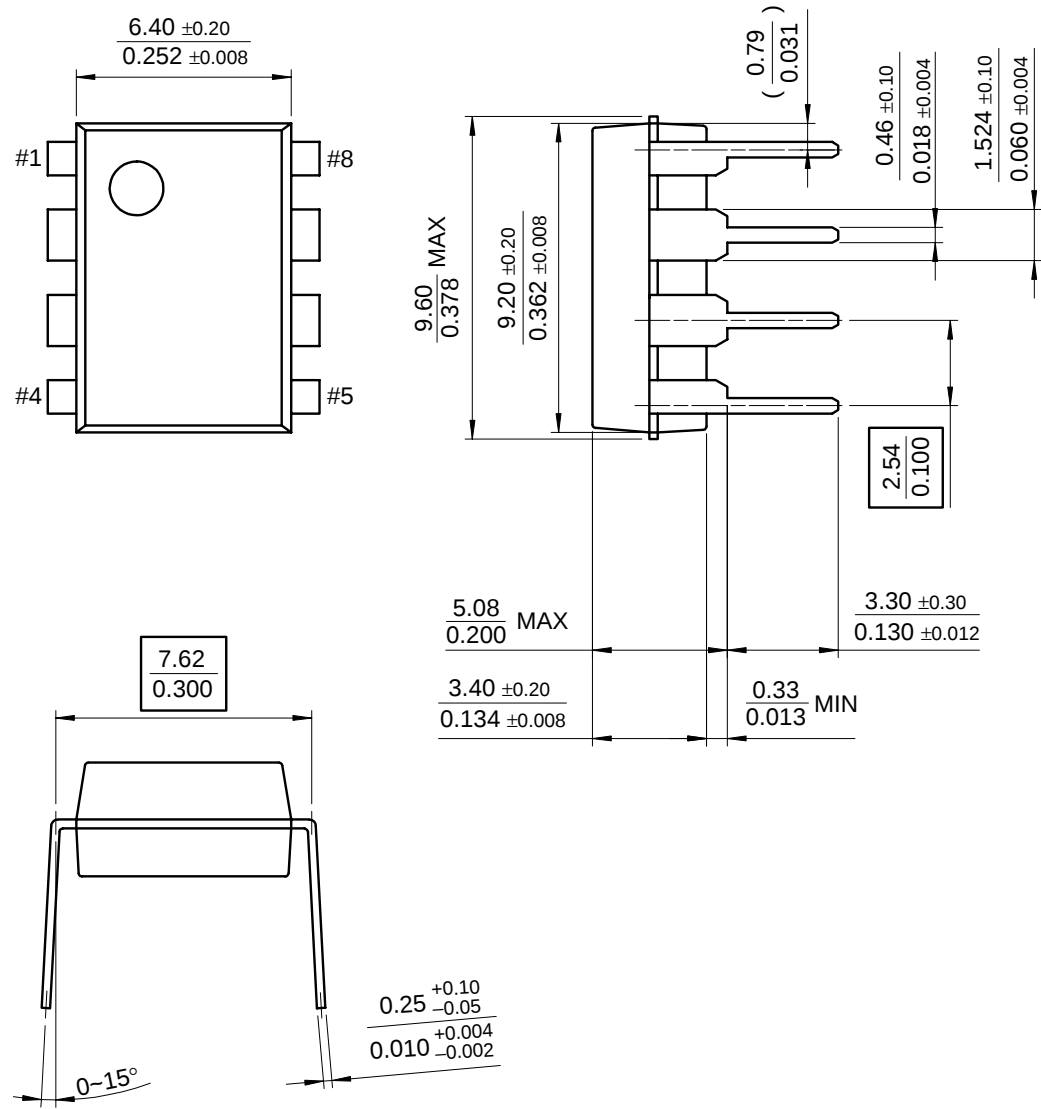
